

Shaker Frame Snowman Card Tutorial

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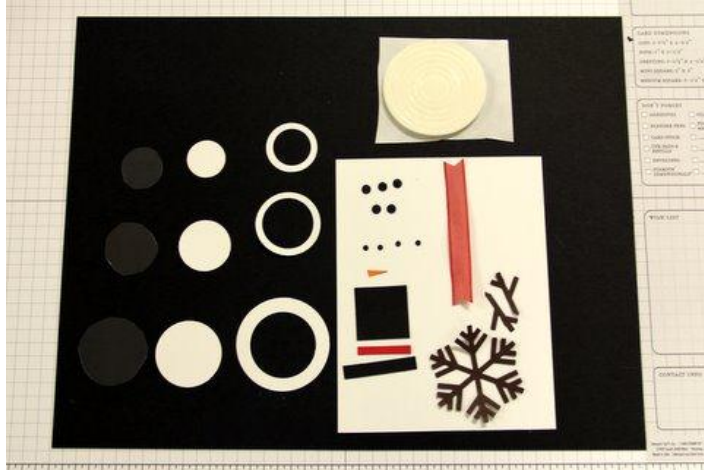
Supplies Needed:

- **Card Stock** - Whisper White, Marine Mist, Basic Black, Early Espresso, Real Red, Pumpkin Pie
- **Punches** – $\frac{3}{4}$ " circle, 1" circle, $1\frac{1}{4}$ " circle, $1\frac{3}{4}$ " circle, Snowflake, 1" square, $1\frac{1}{4}$ " square, Owl Punch, Cupcake Builder
- **Supplies** – Window Sheet, Shaker Frames, Mica Flakes, Riding Hood Red $\frac{3}{8}$ " taffeta ribbon, Stampin' Dimensionals

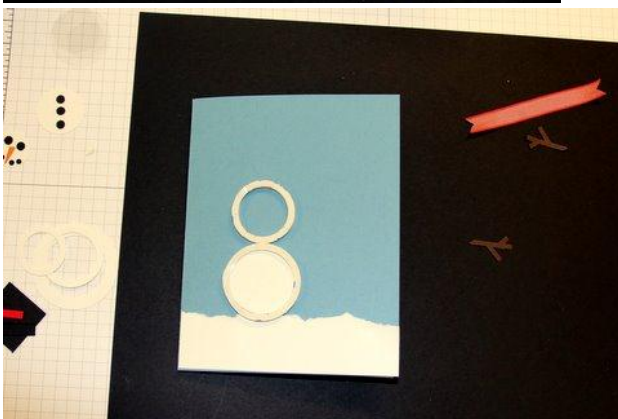
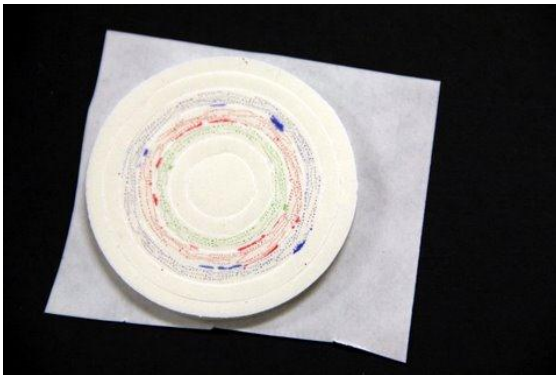
1. Fold Marine Mist card stock in half for card base. Tear a piece of $4\frac{1}{4}$ " x 2" piece of Whisper White card stock and adhere to bottom of card front.
2. Punch out the following rings from Whisper White card stock:
 - a. Head – $\frac{3}{4}$ " & 1"
 - b. Middle – 1" & $1\frac{1}{4}$ "
 - c. Bottom – $1\frac{1}{4}$ " & $1\frac{3}{4}$ "

You will need all six pieces.

3. Cut 1", $1\frac{1}{4}$ " and $1\frac{3}{4}$ " circles from window sheet. (You will not be able to punch the window sheet)
4. Punch 5 "sprinkles" from the Cupcake Builder punch for the eyes and buttons. Punch 4 of the smallest dots from the Owl punch for the mouth.
5. Cut a small triangle from Pumpkin Pie for the nose.



6. Adhere the buttons to the Middle circle (1" circle) and the eyes, nose and mouth to the Head (3/4" circle).
7. You will need three Shaker Frames (see photo for sizes needed).
Note: Do not remove any of the adhesive protection from the top of the shaker frame until after you have put in the Mica Flakes.



8. Adhere the largest of the three marked shaker frames on the "snow". Insert the 1 ¼" circle into the shaker frame.
9. Insert the second largest above and touching the bottom frame. Adhere the scarf so it will be between the head and the middle frames. Insert the 1" circle with the buttons into the middle frame.



10. Adhere the head above, but touching the middle shaker frame. Insert the face.
11. Sprinkle Mica Flakes as desired into each frame.
12. As you remove each of the protective rings, adhere the corresponding card stock ring over it. (1 ¾" ring for the bottom, 1 ¼" card stock ring for the middle, and the 1" ring for the head).
13. To make his arms, punch out a snowflake from Early Espresso card stock. Cut off 2 "spokes". Trim as shown and adhere to card.
14. Punch a 1" square from Basic Black. Insert a scrap of Real Red part way (aprox. 1/8") into the punch to make the red band. Adhere to hat aprox. ½" from the bottom. Trim one side of the hat to make it more of a rectangle. Punch a strip of Basic Black with the 1 ¼" square punch for the brim of the hat.
15. Attach the hat with 3 dimensionals stacked in top of each other. This will line the hat up with the snowman.
